## **Tokyo Disneyland and Tokyo DisneySea Parks Attendance Figures for the First Half of Fiscal Year 2018**

URAYASU, CHIBA—Tokyo Disney Resort® announced today that the total combined attendance at Tokyo Disneyland® Park and Tokyo DisneySea® Park during the first half of this fiscal year (April 1 to September 30, 2018) amounted to a figure of 15,518,000 persons (an increase of 743,000 persons or 105.0% of the attendance figure for the same period last year). This attendance figure is the highest in the history of the Park.

During the first half of this fiscal year, the special event “Tokyo Disney Resort 35th ‘Happiest Celebration!’” brought new contents to both Parks, including a new parade “Dreaming Up!” and the nighttime spectacular “Celebrate! Tokyo Disneyland,” drawing Guests to the Park for the 35th anniversary year.

The newly enhanced attraction, “it’s a small world,” which re-opened in April also proved to be highly popular.

Tokyo Disney Resort is planning the addition of new major attractions as it continues in its endeavors to create fulfilling Park experiences for all Guests.
