Oriental Land Becomes the First Company in Japan's Hotel, Restaurant, Leisure, and Tourism Industry to Receive SBTi Validation of its Net-Zero Targets

Oriental Land Co., Ltd., hereby announces that it has become the first company in Japan's hotel, restaurant, leisure, and tourism industry to receive validation from the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) for its SBT net-zero targets.



SBTi is an international organization that encourages companies to set greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reduction targets in alignment with scientific evidence. SBTi's validation standards are consistent with the goal of limiting global warming to 1.5°C above the pre-industrial global average temperature. That is the goal set forth in the Paris Agreement, an international framework for climate change measures.

In fiscal 2022, the Oriental Land Group (OLC Group) designated measures to address climate change and natural disasters as a Materiality area, and has been striving to reduce GHG emissions. In April 2025, the OLC Group set a new GHG emissions reduction target to further its efforts to help achieve a decarbonized society.

As a result, the OLC Group's Scopes 1 and 2 reduction targets for 2030, as well as its overall reduction targets for 2050 covering Scopes 1, 2, and 3, aligned with the Paris Agreement's 1.5°C target, and have been validated as meeting SBTi's Net-Zero Standard.
